In this activity, we will learn how make pop up cards. You can make cards for family and friends. You make multiple cards and sell them to raise money for a cause you like.

**Timeframe:** 20-30 Minutes  
**Materials:** Cardboard  
Paper  
Construction Paper  
Scissors / Boxcutter  
Ribbon  
Tape  
Pens / Pencils

### Instructions:

Take cardstock and fold it in half horizontally. Cut construction paper and fold it. Cut it to be the same size as your cardstock. Cut the folded side of your colored construction paper, making the cuts which will act as the pop-ups. For a birthday cake, make two large, one medium, and one small cut, from bottom to top. Fold your construction paper the opposite way, making the cake pop out. Glue your colored paper onto the outside cardstock. Decorate the card as you like.
